Dress Code 6-12 Grades

At Liberty Christian Academy, we believe that student appearance should reflect modesty, neatness, and a commitment to honoring Christ. We appreciate the partnership of our parents in helping students arrive at school dressed appropriately and ready to learn.

General Expectations

- Clothing should be neat, modest, and in good condition.
- Apparel that is offensive, inappropriate, distracting, or does not reflect a positive Christian testimony should not be worn.
- If there is ever a question regarding the appropriateness of an item, parents are encouraged to contact the school administration before purchasing or sending the student to school.

Uniform Tops

- All students must wear an official LCA uniform shirt with the LCA crest.
- The bottom button on polo shirts should remain buttoned at all times.
- Oxford shirts may have only the top button unbuttoned.
- Non-uniform shirts may not be worn during the school day.
- On approved game days, student-athletes may wear designated team apparel as approved by the administration.
- When wearing Bulldog outerwear with a zipper, students must wear an LCA uniform shirt underneath. Uniform shirts are not required under approved sweatshirts; however, if the sweatshirt is removed during the day, a uniform shirt must be worn.

Pants and Shorts

Boys

- Approved colors are khaki, navy blue, and gray.
- Pants and shorts should be similar in style, material, and fit to the approved Lands' End uniform options.
- Cargo pants, joggers, corduroys, and cargo shorts are permitted.
- Pants and shorts should fit appropriately and be worn around the waist.
- Shorts may not be more than two inches above the knee.
- Jeans, jean-style pants, and capris are not permitted.
- Clothing may not be frayed, contain holes, or display writing or graphics.

Girls

- Approved colors are khaki, navy blue, and gray.
- Pants and capris should be similar in style, material, and fit to the approved Lands' End uniform options.
- Cargo pants, cargo capris, joggers, and corduroys are permitted.
- Clothing should fit modestly and appropriately.
- Jeans, jean-style pants, leggings, jeggings, sweatpants, lounge pants, and tights are not permitted.
- Skirts are not permitted.

Outerwear

- Only official Bulldog apparel may be worn during the school day.
- Students may wear other coats or jackets to school; however, these items must be stored in lockers during the school day.

Hair and Grooming

Boys

- Hair should be neat and well-groomed, remaining above the eyebrows, not extending over the collar, and no longer than the middle of the ears.
- Hair should be natural in color and style.
- Hair accessories such as beads, rubber bands, headbands, and extensions are not permitted.
- Facial hair should be neatly trimmed and well-maintained.
- Sideburns should not extend below the bottom of the ear.

Girls

- Hair should be clean, neat, and natural in color and style.
- Extreme or distracting hairstyles, including painted hair or wide stripes, are not permitted.

Jewelry and Accessories

- Hats, caps, beanies, bandanas, sunglasses, and other headwear may not be worn inside the building.
- Boys may not wear body piercings.
- Girls may wear earrings and one small nose stud. Hoops, septum rings, and additional facial piercings are not permitted.

Footwear

- Athletic shoes, dress shoes, Birkenstock-style sandals, dress sandals, and closed-toe Crocs are permitted.
- Flip-flops, athletic slides, slippers, and bedroom shoes are not permitted.
- Shoes with laces must be tied.

Athletic and Extracurricular Events

Students attending athletic or extracurricular events are expected to dress modestly and appropriately. Bulldog apparel is encouraged.

- Undergarments should not be visible.
- Shirts must be worn at all times.
- Low-cut tops, spaghetti straps, crop tops, and excessively short shorts are not permitted.

Formal Events

Young Men

- Students should wear a suit or tuxedo.

Young Women

- Formal and semi-formal dresses should be modest in neckline, back, slit length, overall style, and length, with the midriff fully covered.
- Families with questions about formal attire are encouraged to contact the Dean of Women for guidance.
